

Pastor's Letter

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

It's incredible that we are already in the middle of the month of May, the month of Mary, a month that we dedicate to exalt the virtues of our mother. As Catholic Christians we must have a great love for Our Lady, because she as a mother always intercedes for us her children; Saint John Bosco used to say that "Devotion and love for the Most Holy Mary is a protection and a powerful weapon against the snares of the devil", so this month let us pray with more intensity with the Holy Rosary and place all our prayers and intentions at the feet of the mother. This weekend, we are going to coronate of our Mother, and we will re-consecrate ourselves to her and her maternal protection. This Sunday within the Eucharist we are going to crown her with a lot of love.

On Saturday, May 14th, 20 children from our catechetical program received Holy Communion for the first time. I congratulate them on their first encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist. For me it is a special celebration because these children are the future of the church. I congratulate and thank the catechists Ulmi Velasco, Yaly Alvarado, Karla Alemán, and María Eugenia Garza who have prepared them with great dedication, have made an effort to educate them in the faith and show them the way to heaven; I also invite all parents to continue educating their children in the faith.


In this same way, I would like to invite all of you to love the sacraments more, especially the sacrament of the Eucharist. I have noticed that some people with this pandemic have accommodated themselves by receiving the Holy Eucharist and doing so mechanically. We must not forget that in the Eucharist we receive a living Jesus who comes to our hearts. I am concerned that love and respect for what is most sacred in our Catholic faith will be lost. Whenever we receive the Eucharist, we must respond with joy and devotion, "Amen". That phrase is an affirmation that



we believe in Him and it is a deep expression of love. In the same way, we must take a few minutes of silence and recollection either by kneeling or sitting in our seat. I have noticed that after communion many people leave the church immediately; this hurts me because it gives me the impression that they do not have the time to remain silent and to thank God for so much love. Do not forget that Mass ends with the final blessing and the final song, and if you are in a hurry, it

is better not to receive and make a spiritual communion than to make a sacrilege of such a great sacrament. I always ask Jesus for forgiveness on behalf of all those who perhaps unconsciously make these small reparations.

Finally, I appreciate the understanding and support shown by many of you, with the protocols taken in the face of the possible threat of protests due to the situation in the area. I invite you not to be afraid, and to continue praying tirelessly because the devil at no time can make us retreat. Thank God it was all just a threat, but we always have to "be prepared because the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour and we must resist him with great faith" (1 Peter 5:8)



Carta del Párroco

Queridos hermanos en Jesús y María

Increíble pero ya estamos a la mitad del mes de mayo, el mes de María, un mes que dedicamos a exaltar las virtudes de nuestra madre. Como Cristianos Católicos debemos de tener un amor grande a nuestra señora, porque ella como madre siempre intercede por nosotros sus hijos; San Juan Bosco decía que “La devoción y el amor a María Santísima es una protección y un arma poderosa contra las asechanzas del demonio”, por eso este mes oremos con mas intensidad con el Santo Rosario y

pongamos a los pies de la madre todas nuestras intenciones. En este contexto, este fin de semana vamos hacer la coronación de nuestra Madre, y nos reconsagraremos a ella y a su maternal protección. Este domingo dentro de la Eucaristía vamos a hacer este acto de coronación con mucho amor.

El sábado 14 de mayo, 20 niños de nuestro programa de catequesis han recibido la Sagrada Comunión por primera vez, les felicito por su primer encuentro con Jesús Eucaristía, para mí es una fiesta especial porque ellos son el futuro de la iglesia. No hay que olvidar que en la Eucaristía recibimos a Jesús vivo que viene a nuestro corazón. 

Gracias a Dios todo fue solo una amenaza, pero siempre tenemos que “estar

preparados porque el demonio como león rugiente ronda buscando a quien devorar y debemos resistirle con mucha fe” (1Pe.5, 8).
