We will need your birth and baptismal (if applicable) certificate/s.

For couples married outside of the Church, our priests are willing to help you prepare for the Sacrament of Matrimony, an important step to receiving the other Sacraments and living the Catholic faith. Religious Education QofA's Religious Education program welcomes students from kindergarten (age 5) through high school. Grades are close to capacity - please do not delay! The first day of class is Sunday, **Sep. 10**, 9 am with doors opening at 8 am. Please arrive no later than 8:30 am for sign-in. Priests will meet with parents at 9 am.

Registration fees: \$70+\$20 for 1 child; \$120+\$20 for 2 children; \$150+\$20 for 3+ children in the same family. We accept cash and check payable to Queen of Apostles. Registration fees do not include fees associated with sacraments.

New students need to provide birth and baptismal certificates. Families with unbaptized children under the age of 7 years old are asked to call the parish office at (703) 54-8711.

Students are assigned to the Religious Education grade that parallel his/her public school grade. Students must attend two consecutive years of Religious Education before a sacrament is administered (Generally, First Penance/First Holy Communion are received in grade 2 and higher; Confirmation is received in grade 8 and higher).

Thank you for considering Queen of Apostles Religious Education Program. It is an opportunity for your child to grow and live the Catholic faith by learning to pray, knowing the Bible, learning Scripture, and preparing for and living the Sacraments.

Pastor's Letter Our Lady, Queen of Apostles

August is marked by the beautiful celebration of the Assumption of Mary (August 15). Eight days later, the Liturgy of the Church celebrates the Queenship of Mary. (August 22). Our parish celebrates its Feast Day on the Sunday between August 15 and 22.

Devotion to Mary, Queen of Apostles is one of the oldest devotions in the Church. Aware of Mary's singular role in the birth of the Church, the Acts of the Apostles highlight the presence of Mary with the disciples (Acts 1:14). Thus, Blessed James Alberione says, "The first devotion that we find in the Church is the devotion to the Queen of Apostles, as portrayed in the Cenacle... Let us return to the sources. At the sources we find Mary, Queen of the Apostles, and if it was so at the beginning of the Church, there is nothing more certain than to draw from the ancient Faith. The water is purer when it is taken from its source."

The title Queen of Apostles brings us back to Pentecost, which is represented in a very beautiful way in our church's sanctuary. Above is the Holy Trinity, the Father and

the Son are depicted sending forth the Holy Spirit. Mary was already overshadowed by the Holy Spirit in the Incarnation. Then, when the Church –the body of Christ– was about to be born, Mary was once more filled with the Holy Spirit, who descended on the Apostles, sending them forth to preach the good news to all the nations.

The Daughters of St. Paul explain the devotion to Mary, Queen of Apostles in this way: "Mary is Queen of the Apostles because she was chosen to be the Mother of Jesus Christ and to give Him to the world; she was made the Apostles' Mother and our own by our Savior on the Cross; she was with the Apostles while awaiting the descent of the Holy Spirit, obtaining from them the abundance of supernatural graces they received on Pentecost."

We ourselves have shared in this gift of the Holy Spirit in the Pentecost of our Confirmation. By this sacramental gift we are sent forth to bring the joy of the Gospel to our world. "Under the protection of our Blessed Mother and guided by the Holy Spirit, our mission is to form disciples of Christ."

In this endeavor we can turn to Mary for protection as our Mother and Queen, with the beautiful words Pope Leo XIII wrote of Mary in the Cenacle: "With wonderful care she nurtured the first Christians by her holy example, her authoritative counsel, her sweet consolation, her fruitful prayers. She was in very truth, the Mother of the Church, the Teacher and Queen of the Apostles, to whom, besides; she confided no small part of the divine mysteries which she kept in her heart" (Leo XIII, Adiutricem Populi).

May Our Lady, Queen of Apostles bless you all in this beautiful Feast.


