Pastor's Letter

Marriage is Good News

Today, along with the fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time, we celebrate World Marriage Day. It is part of the week before Saint Valentine's Day, in which the Church invites us to celebrate, promote and defend marriage and the family.

In a society which is divided on political and ethical issues; in a society which considers marriage as an unnecessary burden and exalts transgenderism and homosexuality; in a society which sets a successful career as the paradigm of self-accomplishment to which all, even family, can be sacrificed... Marriage seems to be an underdog.

However Marriage is good news. "The family is the privileged setting where every person learns to give and receive love [...] The family is a necessary good for peoples, an indispensable foundation for society and a great and lifelong treasure for couples" (Benedict XVI, World Meeting Families, July 8, 2006). And marriage is blessed and guarded by the grace of the sacrament of Marriage.

Today's readings can give us rich insight to approach the good news of marriage. Marriage is a vocation to holiness in conjugal love and family life. God is the one calling, like He did with Isaiah: "Whom shall I send? Who will go for us?" (Is 6:8). Likewise, Jesus invites the expert fishermen to try again: "Put out into deep water and lower your nets for a catch" (Lk 5:4).

Man and woman, created in the image and likeness of God who is love, are called to conjugal love. This is the Gospel which has been preached to us: "I am reminding you, brothers and sisters, of the gospel I preached to you, which you indeed received and in which you also stand" (1 Cor 15:1).

"Authentic married love is caught up into divine love and is governed and enriched by Christ's redeeming power and the saving activity of the Church, so that this love may lead the spouses to God with powerful effect and may aid and strengthen them in sublime office of being a father or a mother [...] By virtue of this sacrament, as spouses fulfil their conjugal and family obligation, they are penetrated with the spirit of Christ, which suffuses their whole lives with faith, hope and charity" (Vatican II, Gaudium et Spes #48).

This miracle of love and grace is what husband and wife are called to live. Even in the midst of challenges and difficulties couples should not lose heart. God's grace is at work with them. "There is a temptation which perennially besets every spiritual journey and pastoral work: that of thinking that the results depend on our ability to act and to plan [...] We then share the experience of the disciples in the Gospel story of the miraculous catch of fish: 'We have toiled all night and caught nothing' (Lk 5:5). This is the moment of faith, of prayer, of conversation with God, in order to open our hearts to the tide of grace and allow the word of Christ to pass through us in all its power: Duc in altum!" (St. John Paul II, Novo Millennio Ineunte #38).

Dear couples and families, renew this act of faith and trust and put out into deep water once more. And, at Jesus' words, let down your nets (Lk 5:5).
