Pastor's Letter

Super Bowl Lessons

First of all, congratulations to all our Patriots fans. The Falcons have a great opportunity of learning from their mistakes and working toward another great season.

The conclusion of the Super Bowl means the start of another February celebration. There are red and pink flowers and hearts all around: St. Valentine is coming. Our society celebrates love which is romantic, quixotic, exciting, beautiful, and sweet... And it is true that there is all that in love, but it is also true that there is much more. There is a mysterious power which enables you to promise to give yourself completely for the rest of your life.

The Church celebrates along with our society. This weekend is World Marriage Day, and mother Church wants "to celebrate the gift and blessing of marriage and to affirm and support engaged and married couples" (Archbishop Chaput).

I would like to pick three lessons from the Super Bowl to inspire couples to succeed in their love

First, don't relax. You need to fight for each yard. Fight each day to renew the fascination of love, to make it magical, to conquer your beloved's heart, to avoid routine at all cost. Be humble in forgiving and ask forgiveness if you fumble the ball and the other teams scores a touchdown. And remember, your coach is Jesus Christ, and with his grace he will heal your teammates' tears.

Second, never give up! Marriage and family life, as beautiful as it is, is also very challenging. And many times there will be the temptation to lose heart and hope. Certainly, the Patriots didn't lose hope. If any Patriots fan turned the TV off and went to bed that evening, he is probably regretting it now. In this game of marriage we have more that Tom Brady: we have the Holy Spirit to inspire us and create a move that will break through the difficulties and change the score.

Finally, the goal is to win the game. It is not enough to be ahead for three quarters. The goal for a couple is more than to marry and have children. It is to share the whole journey of life. It is to be holy. That involves a lot of sacrifice, work, hope, courage, perseverance and humility... and God's grace which never fails even when we do. And it is worth it. Ask the Patriots fans.
