# Super Bowl 2018

#### GO EAGLES!



It is not that I am trying to gain the Bishop's favor. The Super Bowl is a great event in our country, and these days there are many conversations about it. Plans have been made some time ago to watch it. Most likely our Bishop as well. He, as it is well known, is a big Eagles' fan. However, most likely he will not watch it live because he will have other ministerial duties. Today we read in the Sunday Gospel: "Everyone is looking for you" (Mk 1:37). And I can't help but to think sarcastically, "sorry Jesus; no offense but everyone is looking for the Super Bowl."

Dear parish family, Who are we looking for?

I would like to make two remarks on today's readings. The first is about God's healing grace. Jesus heals Peter's mother-in-law and many others. In his misery, Job looks up to heaven and cries to God, "My days are swifter than a weaver's shuttle/ they come to an end without hope / Remember that my life is like the wind / I shall not see happiness again" (Job 7:6-7). Maybe this text will console many in New England on Sunday evening.

Sometimes we feel miserable and, like Job, we cry out to heaven. We ask God to assist us. And rightly so. He is our Father and sure enough we should cry out to him in need. And it is a good way to learn to look up so that in good times we will also look up to give thanks and praise our heavenly Father. Hopefully, on Sunday evening many will praise God because they are with the Eagles on Cloud 9.

The second remark is about what happens when we look up to heaven. Jesus, "Rising very early before dawn, he left and went off to a deserted place, where he prayed" (Mk 1:35). In prayer Jesus embraces the Father's will and sets himself ready to continue preaching in other villages. Likewise, Paul is in fire and is prompted to preach the Gospel: "and woe to me if I do not preach it!" (1 Cor 9:16).

So back to my question, Who are we looking for? Today's readings invite us to refocus and pay attention to what is essential for us: prayer, in which we embrace God's will and do not neglect our call to evangelize. This Sunday the Eagles fans will have the need to call others and share their joy. We have Jesus' joy. Wouldn't we want to share it?
