#### Pastor's Letter

Our parish family has been preparing well for this grace-filled season of Lent. The Church invites us during this sacred time to practice prayer, fasting, and alms giving. Two weeks ago, our families came during the Holy Hour to again root their marriage and family in the heart of Christ, fount of all life. Last week on Thursday, almost 100 parishioners came again to spend an hour with the Blessed Sacrament. They united in prayer under three intentions: the holiness of our priests and reparation for their sins, the dignity and sanctity of marriage, and the end of violence. The Spirit continues to do great things in the Church and especially here at Queen of Apostles. This Lent, may He move our hearts to seek the Lord in prayer and may he teach us how to pray.

On Sunday, following one of the Masses, a parishioner came to me and said: "Father, I thought I was not going to be able to fast last Thursday, but I did. I didn't even have coffee and I felt great." We are never outdone in generosity. Hopefully, this will serve as an encouragement to many of us. The Church asks us to fast on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday and to abstain from meat every Friday of the year. However, perhaps some of us will want to fast these Fridays during Lent. As always, we do so offering it to the Lord for a particular intention. We could offer it for ourselves or for someone else.

Alms giving is aligned to Christian charity. We deprive ourselves of something, which helps us detach ourselves from things (money, time, etc.) to benefit someone else. This past Sunday, the Women's Group prepared a breakfast for our Religious Education catechists! Indeed, this was a great act of charity, whereby our parish family looks after one another and expresses our gratitude for their service to others. Certainly, this is a great way in which our parish family disposes itself to live these 40 days.

Speaking of Religious Education, last Saturday, Fr. Jaime led a retreat for 8th graders and high schoolers, many of whom are preparing for the Sacrament of Confirmation. It was staffed by great leaders, including school teachers, catechists, the youth ministry coordinator, and other parishioners. During Religious Education, we also held a meeting with the parents of those who will be receiving this sacrament. They were asked to make a commitment to say a prayer to the Holy Spirit every day for the confirmandi. Feel free to join us in doing this.

On their journey to the Sacrament of Communion, the 2nd graders at Queen of Apostles School and in Religious Education have prepared for and will be making their First Confession on Saturday, February 29. Certainly, it is a great way to prepare for the Sacrament of Communion, but also the perfect way to begin the Lenten season. We all recall the excitement and the nervousness we felt. In fact, after many years and many times of going to Confession, we sometimes still feel the nervousness and embarrassment. Unfortunately, we forget the excitement of knowing that God is ready to forgive us and that it is an opportunity for us to experience once more God's great love for us, his healing power. Be sure to make time to encounter Jesus in this sacrament this Lent. All the parishes in the Diocese of Arlington, including ours, will participate in The Light is On for You. All parishes will hold Confessions every Wednesday from 6:30 PM to 8:30 PM.

May the Lord help us this sacred season of Lent to again set our gaze on Him, and discover the mercy and the many riches of his Sacred Heart. .
