What are scrutinies? Scrutinies are held on the 3rd, 4th, and 5th Sundays of Lent for the unbaptized children and adults who are preparing to receive the three Sacraments of Initiation during the Easter season. Scrutinies, are meant to uncover, and then heal all that is weak, defective, or sinful in the hearts of The Elect; to bring out, then strengthen all that is upright, strong, and good. For the scrutinies are celebrated in order to deliver The Elect from the power of sin and Satan, to protect them against temptation, and to give them strength in Christ, who is the way, the truth, and the life. These rites, therefore, should complete the conversion of The Elect and deepen their resolve to hold fast to Christ and to carry out their decision to love God above all. (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults, 141)

We continue our Lenten journey with God's invitation resounding in our hearts: "Return to me with your whole heart." We continue to journey with the certainty that our Heavenly Father inclines his ear to our petitions. He is always listening to our hearts and is attentive to our needs. Let us continue to frequently turn our gaze to Christ by partaking in the century old practices of our faith, including decades-long practices of our own parish family.

Two ways that come to mind in terms of setting our gaze on Christ are the Adoration Chapel and the Stations of the Cross.



If you do not do so already, I want to invite you this Lent to make a visit to the **Adoration Chapel** maybe on your way to work or on your way back from work. Or if the Spirit so moves you, maybe you can commit to becoming an adorer for an hour a week. This month, Queen of Apostles adorers will be offering their Lenten prayers and sacrifices for our Queen of Apostles School teachers, for an increase in school enrollment, and also for protection from and a cure for the coronavirus.

Another way in which we may want to return to God with all our heart is by approaching the Sacrament of Confession. As you know, last week, both the Religious Education as well as Queen of Apostles School students experienced for the first time God's mercy in this sacrament. Let us find the time and courage to return to Our Lord in this manner. Many confession times are available for you. Please take a look again at the times published in the bulletin. Let Christ be truly a victor over our sins.

One last thought: The youth participating in Emmaus have also embarked on living Lent in a special way, offering sacrifices for different intentions. With other intentions or goals, they have given up the snooze button on the alarm (!!), and also they decided to use the money they would have spent on coffee as a donation for a person in need.

Perhaps as a family or as a ministry we can still brainstorm some ways to return to the Lord with our whole heart.
