**Religious Education** Religious Education Registration for the **2017-2018** school year is open. QofA's Religious Education program welcomes students from Kindergarten (age 5) through high school. Returning students must register each year. New students need to bring birth and baptismal certificates. The first day of RE is **Sep. 10**.

Registration fees: \$70 for 1 child; \$120 for 2 children; \$150 for 3+ children in the same family. Queen of Apostles parishioners and returning students are given priority for enrollment. We accept cash and check payable to Queen of Apostles. Registration fees do not include fees associated with sacraments.

Students are assigned to the Religious Education grade that parallels his/her public school grade. Students must attend two consecutive years of Religious Education before a sacrament is administered (generally, First Penance/First Holy Communion are received in grade 2 and higher; Confirmation is received in grade 8 and higher). Families with unbaptized children under the age of 7 years old are asked to call the parish office at (703) 354-8711. Thank you for considering Queen of Apostles Religious Education Program.

# Pastor's Letter

### The Priest and the Eucharist

Today we celebrate Good Shepherd Sunday. It is a day to give thanks to the Lord for the priests and to pray for vocations.

As we hear today in the Gospel, Jesus is "the Shepherd of the sheep" (Jn 10:2), our good Shepherd.

Jesus, who gave us the Sacraments, gave us also the Sacrament of Holy Orders. In his mercy he knew that we would be overwhelmed if we had to approach him, the High Priest who is in the Sanctuary of Heaven, filled with the Glory of God. Thus he provided us a fitting means to approach him: the priests. Men like us who would not inspire terror or distress. Men who

in their weakness would stir our trust and confidence. Men who in their generous service will encourage us to advance in holiness. We give thanks for the gift of the priest, and we remember with gratitude those priests who marked us in a decisive way.

We also pray for vocations. And let me ask: what are we doing to promote vocations in our families? With the Eucharist being the "center and root of the whole priestly life" (II Vatican Council, Presbyterorum Ordinis 14), a great way to promote vocations is to be ourselves a Eucharistic family, each household and the whole Parish Family. Through daily Mass and Communion, Eucharistic Adoration, visits to the Church, spiritual Communion... we can grow as a Eucharistic family.

On July 1, 1990 St. John Paul II said during the Angelus:

"It is fitting that seminarians take part every day in the Eucharistic celebration, in such a way that afterward they will take up as a rule of their priestly life this daily celebration. They should, moreover, be trained to consider the Eucharistic celebration as the essential moment of their day, in which they will take an active part and at which they will never be satisfied with a merely habitual attendance. Finally, candidates to the priesthood will be trained to share in the intimate dispositions which the Eucharist fosters: gratitude for heavenly benefits received, because the Eucharist is thanksgiving; an attitude of self - offering, which will impel them to unite the offering of themselves to the Eucharistic offering of Christ; charity nourished by a sacrament which is a sign of unity and sharing; the yearning to contemplate and bow in adoration before Christ, who is really present under the Eucharistic species."

If this becomes our lifestyle, vocations will flourish in our Parish Family for the good of the Church and the Glory of God.



# Rule of Life for the Month of May Lectio Divina

**(MAY)** Lectio Divina "And Mary kept all these things, reflecting on them in her heart" (Lk 2:19). In May, we go to the school of Mary to learn the art of *Lectio Divina*, an ancient tradition of prayerful reading of the Bible through four steps:

Lectio - reading/listening

*Meditatio* - letting Scripture wash over my thoughts, hopes, memories, and desires *Oratio* - loving conversation with God

Contemplatio - a wordless and quiet presence of the One Who loves us

**Step** 1: Enthrone the Bible at home in a prominent place.
